“The American Free Enterprise System”

- Essential Questions: How does the free enterprise system work? How are resources allocated in a free enterprise system? What is the role of government in our free enterprise economy?
- Key terms: profit motive, free enterprise system, externality, subsidy, transfer payment, market failure

Task:

- The product MUST answer the essential questions completely.
